Were dinosaur's reptiles, mammals, or amphibians?

Spinosaurus

It is the name of the geological era during which the dinosaurs lived, and mammals evolved.

Plesiosaur

This dinosaur was a huge meat-eater with tiny arms and two-fingered hands.

Diplodocus

This dinosaur was a plant-eater that had three horns on their head. What is it called?

Herbivore

It is the name of the geological time during which the huge plant-eating dinosaurs (like Apatosaurus) and other dinosaurs lived

Apatosaurus

This dinosaur was a large plant-eater that had a series of triangular plates running along its back. It had spikes at the end of its tail.

Mesozoic Era

This dinosaur was a meat-eater that had a sail on its back.

Tyrannosaurus rex

This creature was a large, meat-eating reptile that lived in the seas during the time of the dinosaurs (but it wasn't a dinosaur).

Triceratops

This flying reptile lived during the time of the dinosaurs (but it wasn't a dinosaur). Its name means "wing finger"

Stegosaurus

This plant-eater had a long neck, a small head, and a long, whip-like tail.

Carnivore

This dinosaur was a large plant-eater that used to be called Brontosaurus.

Pterodactyl

It is a word meaning an animal that eats meat. Some dinosaurs were meat-eaters.

Reptiles

It is a word meaning an animal that eats plants. Most dinosaurs were plant-eaters.
